## New Codes, Old Codes, and Changed Interpretations

## Let's See What OASIS-C is All About

**Friday August 21, 2009: 10-11:30am PST**

This is the first major revision to OASIS since its inception in 1999. Changes in 2002 and 2008 do not compare with these planned changes! The changes include an explanation of the new items, including renumbering of current items and CMS's objectives. CMS's goal is self-explanatory descriptions which will reduce the number of questions regarding interpretations. Best practices learned through the outcome projects have been incorporated which will improve your care plans and clinical practices. Not just a review of the proposed changes, but also innovative ideas on readying your clinicians now for the changes.
