The Audio-conference will take place from 10:00am until 11:30am PST.

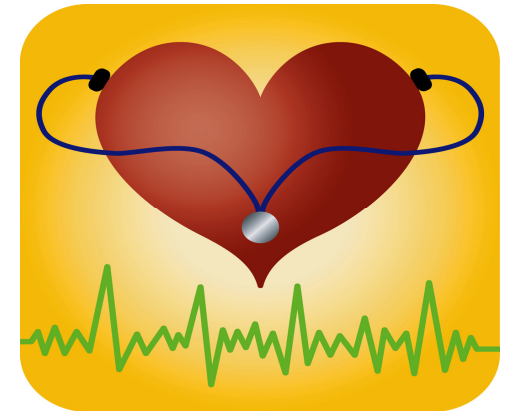
